Make adjustments to your boat in the slings, not at the dock.

To avoid potential collisions, know how many others are on the water.

Do not leave shoes or other items on the dock.

Those leaving the dock have priority over those coming into the dock but leave the dock as quickly as possible.

Those going out should remain closer to the white poles and those returning should stay wide of the poles. Those going out by the green buoy have priority over those coming in.

Row out on the 278 side of Broad Creek and back on the Marshland Road side of the creek.

If you miss the dock when landing, please go around again.

Give those docking ahead of you sufficient time to dock.

When landing, immediately move your boat down toward the wooden dock and remove your boat and oars, from the dock, as quickly as possible.

Consider putting up a third set of slings if the dock is crowded.

When practical, be aware of other rowers landing and be prepared to assist them, if necessary.

When being passed by a motorized boat/craft traveling at "No Wake" speed, please stop rowing so they can get by.
